Licenses who need CEU Credits to Renew

- Pest Control Advisors are required to obtain **15 CEU's** per year of renewal
- Commercial Applicators are required to obtain **6 CEU's** per year of renewal.
- Private Applicators are required to obtain **3 CEU's** per year of renewal.
- Golf Course Applicators are required to obtain **3 CEU's** per year of renewal
- Private Use Fumigation Certification must obtain an **additional 3 CEU's** per year of renewal
- Certifications, licenses and permits are renewable for a 1 or 2 year period, provided enough CEU's have been acquired.
- PUP's, PUG's, PRI's and PCA's are able to count CEU's acquired between **January 1 through December 31**.
- Certifications, licenses and permits expire on **December 31** and must be renewed before they are needed within 30 days.
- If you do not obtain the CEU's required to renew your certification or license by **December 31**— you must retest at one of our office locations in Phoenix, Tucson or Yuma.
