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FEES: THE CONDITIONS OF THE HARVEST RESTRICTED PERMIT ARE AS FOLLOWERS:

- 1. Annual Permit fee is \$35.00
- 2. All unprocessed fibers collected is \$6.00 per ton in lawful US currency, and shall be remitted to the Department of Agriculture, including all weight certificates, no later than the 10th day of the following month in which the fiber was harvested.

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NO HARVESTING CONDUCTED:

In a month where no harvesting was conducted, a written statement shall be submitted to the Department of Agriculture by the 10th of the following month:

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WEIGH CERTIFICATES:

- Shall be submitted with the proper fees no later than the 10th of the following month in which the plants or fibers were harvested.
- Shall be from an approved, bonded scale.

WRITTEN PERMISSION OF LANDOWNER:

- Shall be obtained before each collection.
- Shall be submitted to the Department each time it is obtained from the landowner.
- Shall be in possession with those involved during removal and transportation of native plants.

All permits expire a midnight, December 31, of the current year, unless revoked by either the landowner, or the Department of Agriculture.



PERMIT SHALL BE IN YOUR POSSESSION DURING PLANT COLLECTION

FAILURE TO SUBMIT PROPER FEES, WEIGHT CERTIFICATES, PERMISSION OF THE LANDOWNER OR LETTER STATING, "NO HARVESTING WAS CONDUCTED..." WILL BE GROUNDS FOR PERMIT REVOCATION OR DENIAL.
