- □ Add moisture through ventilation system.
- Clean fans, louvers, and soffit inlets in swine facilities.
- Control vegetation on building exteriors.
- House in fully enclosed ventilated buildings.
- Use no bedding.
- Use slatted floor system.
- Use sloped concrete flooring.

Animal Waste (and Feed) Handling & Transporting (must select at least TWO)

- □ Add oil and/or moisture to feed rations.
- Clean aisles.
- Clean floors and walls in swine facility.
- Enclose transfer points from feed storage to feed distribution system.
- Enclosed feed distribution system
- Maintain liquid lagoon level above manure solids.
- Maintain moisture in manure solids.
- Minimize drop distance.
- Remove spilled feed.
- □ Store feed in enclosed, weatherproof storage structure.
- Stack separated manure solids.
