Arizona industrial hemp producers were able to apply for a license beginning May 31, 2019. The first seeds planted went into the ground on June 7, 2019.

Growers faced many challenges the first year of producing industrial hemp in the State. Some of these included insect pressures, irrigation practices, soil conditions, soil salts, seed germination rates, and extreme heat.

Growers with crops that were determined to be non-compliant were provided an opportunity to propose a corrective action plan prior to disciplinary action. Two methods approved in 2019 were crop blending and homogenization, and on-site THC Removal.




