Arizona law prohibits the sale of agricultural, vegetable or ornamental plant seed containing restricted noxious-weed seeds, singly in excess of limitations, as stated per pound, or in combination of 50 per pound. The label shall show the name and rate of occurrence per pound of each kind of restricted noxious-weed seed present.
