**1. PURPOSE**

This Order is issued to repeal the Arizona Department of Agriculture Director's Administrative Order 06-05 dated May 6, 2006, which placed plant movement quarantines on the glassy-winged sharpshooter and associated hosts originating from infested states and infested portions of California.

With the indication of secondary vectors common in the environment for the bacterial pathogen *Xylella fastidiosa*, the agent that causes Pierce's Disease, and the confirmed presence of the disease within the state, the Plant Services Division of the Arizona Department of Agriculture recognizes that this vector and pathogen is now considered a management issue and no longer sees the validity of continuing an exterior quarantine for the glassy-winged sharpshooter and associated hosts.
