Pest Management Division (PMD) Certified Applicator

Pursuant to <u>A.A.C. R3-8-201</u>, an individual may temporarily provide pest management services on behalf of a business licensee without being a certified applicator if the individual:

- Is registered as an applicator of the business licensee under R3-8-207;
- Has been registered as an applicator of the business licensee for not more than 90 calendar days out of the last 365 days; and
- Is supervised by a certified applicator who:
 - o Is certified in the category for which supervision is provided;
 - Provides immediate supervision when the individual performs pest management services in the wood-destroying organism treatment, aquatic, or fumigation category, uses a restricted use pesticide, or uses a pesticide under an experimental use permit; and
 - Provides direct supervision when the individual performs pest management services not covered in the previous bullet.

Note: This does not apply to pest management services at a school, child care facility, health care institution, or food-handling establishment unless the individual is a certified applicator in the certification category for which services are being provided. Additionally, an individual using an animal to assist with identifying infestations or making inspections for the purpose of identifying or attempting to identify infestations shall be a certified applicator in the certification category for which services are being provided.
