NATIONAL ISSUES

- ▶ **EPA's C&T Website**
 - ▶ **difficult to find and navigate**
 - ▶ **Applicator listings are not updated in a timely manner – EPA Circuit Rider Program & Tribal EPA pesticide program continually contact region office for license status**
- ▶ **Three Affiliated Tribes in North Dakota has a tribal C&T Program**
 - ▶ **Applicators continue to apply RUPs without tribal certification believing the fed/state certification is the only need requirement**
- ▶ **Tribes have concerns about the C&T not requiring liability insurance as the states do and that insurance amount is inadequate**
