

ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES (ADWM)
STAKEHOLDER MEETING
ON THE STAGE II VAPOR RECOVERY PROGRAM
IN THE MARICOPA OZONE NONATTAINMENT AREA

The Arizona Department of Weights and Measures (ADWM), in coordination with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG), will hold a stakeholder meeting to discuss the May 16, 2012 EPA Widespread Use for Onboard Refueling Vapor Recovery (ORVR) Final Rule ([77 FR 28772](#)) and related implications for the Stage II Vapor Recovery Program in the Maricopa Ozone Nonattainment Area as well as discussion of ADWM Vapor Recovery Program statute and rule development.

The stakeholder meeting will be held 2:00 PM Thursday, September 5th, 2013 at the ADEQ Building, Conference Room 3175, 1110 W. Washington St., Phoenix, AZ 85007.

There will be a presentation regarding the status of the future State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision for approval by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to remove stage II vapor recovery within the Maricopa ozone nonattainment area. Additionally, the presentation will review anticipated statutory changes associated with decommissioning of Stage II equipment.
