

Monkeys (in the Macaques Family) Entry Requirements

Importation requirements for monkeys in the family Ceropithecidae (Macaques including Rhesus, Java, Snow, and Pigtail monkeys):

For importation requirements for importation of monkeys that are NOT in the genus Macaca, contact the Arizona Game and Fish Department at 602-942-3000.

Currently all Monkeys are considered a restricted species by Arizona Game and Fish Department.

Prior to any permit issued, you will need to get written approval from Arizona Game and Fish.

With written approval from the Arizona Game and Fish Department, you may apply for a permit to import the Monkey under the following criteria:

- No Macaque may be imported that is less than 50% of its adult weight. (Arizona Game and Fish Restriction)
- Each Macaque must be permanently identified with either a tattoo or a microchip and the identification noted clearly on the CVI.

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)

- Issued by an Accredited II Veterinarian
- Valid for 30 days
- Copies of CVI must have an original signature
- All Official IDs must be listed on CVI or as an attachment

Specific Disease Testing Requirements:

- Negative test for Simian Herpes B Virus within 30 days prior to entry
- Negative test for Tuberculosis conducted within 30 days prior to entry

All results must be listed on the CVI and accompany shipment when the Macaque is transported into Arizona.
