

Rodeo, Exhibition, or Recreational Cattle Entry Requirements

All Cattle Entering Arizona Need:

Entry Permit Number

- Issued by calling 602-542-4293
- 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Mon to Fri AZ Time
- Valid for 30 days

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)

- Issued by an Accredited II Veterinarian
- Valid for 30 days
- Copies of CVI must have an original veterinarian signature
- All Official IDs must be listed on CVI or as an attachment

Official Identification

- Official Identification required on all breeds all ages
- All Official IDs must be recorded on *CVI* or as an attachment to *CVI*

Specific Disease Testing Requirements

Tuberculosis:

- For beef breed cattle, Tuberculosis testing is NOT required, unless the state of origin has a Tuberculosis Quarantine in effect.
 - In states that have a bovine tuberculosis quarantine in effect; all cattle 3 months of age and older must test negative within **60** days prior to entry into Arizona.
- Tuberculosis testing required on all dairy breed cattle greater than 3 months of age. All cattle must test negative within 60 days prior to entry.

Brucellosis:

Testing required if cattle originates from Idaho, Wyoming, Montana.

Trichomonas:

- No preentry requirements for bulls if consigned directly to an exhibition or show.
- Statement on CVI "The bulls listed on this CVI are consigned to _____(show or exhibition) and are not for breeding activity or sale in the state of Arizona."
- If a bull is intended to be sold after the show or exhibition, Trichomonas testing is required prior to entry.
