



Swine Entry Requirements

All Swine Prior to Entry into Arizona Need:

Entry Permit Number

- Issued by calling **602-542-4293**
- 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Mon to Fri AZ Time
- Valid for 15 days

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)

- Issued by an Accredited II Veterinarian
- Valid for **10** days
- Copies of CVI must have an original signature
- All Official IDs must be listed on the CVI or as an attachment
- The CVI must include the following verified statements:

“The Swine listed on this CVI have not been fed garbage.”

“The Swine listed on this CVI have not been vaccinated for Pseudorabies.”

Swine should include Commercial, Show, Pet/ Companion, including Potbelly and Minipigs.

Official Identification for Swine include:

- Official Federal Individual Ear Tag (840, USDA, NUES)



- Ear Notch is acceptable but not required pursuant to the Director’s Administrative Order dated 1/23/2014. If Ear notch is used without an Official Federal Ear Tag, a premises identification tattoo must be used.
- (Potbelly or Minipigs ONLY) 840 electronic implants or microchips that are ISO 11784/85 compliant with a premise ID listed on CVI.
- Slaughter Swine must have USDA backtags.
