



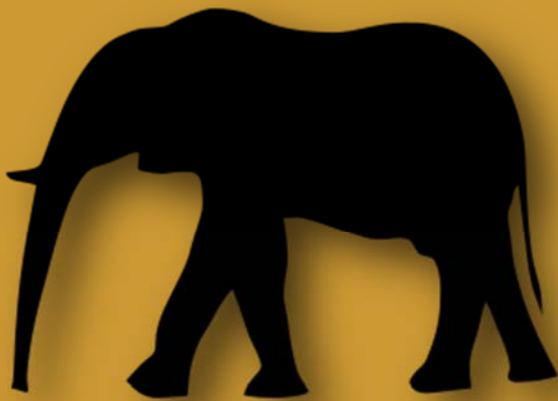
Zoo Animal Entry Requirements

An owner or owner’s agent may transport or move zoo animals into the state of Arizona if the animals are accompanied by a CVI.

- Zoo animals may only be consigned to a Zoo, Circus, or Show.

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)

- Issued by an Accredited II Veterinarian
- Valid for 30 days
- Copies of the CVI must have an original signature



Specific Disease Testing Requirements:

Animals in “Petting Zoos” must have a negative test for Tuberculosis within 12 months prior to entry into Arizona.

All Petting Zoos must be licensed with the USDA Animal Care Department. For more information go to:
