

If you work for a governmental agency, please bring an agency identification card, a business card or a letter (on agency letterhead) stating that you work for a governmental agency. The test administrator will make a note on your exam paperwork so that the Dept. of Agriculture's licensing staff will know that you are exempt from paying annual licensing fees.

Description of Exams and Licenses

The **National Pesticide Applicator Core Exam** is a 90-question, multiple-choice exam. Test takers are allowed 90 minutes to complete the exam. In Arizona, people who are interested in getting either a Private or Commercial Applicator's license take the National Core Exam as their base test.

The **category exams** are also multiple-choice tests. Most contain 50 questions. You may use as much time as you need to complete the category exams. Many people who work for governmental agencies choose to take both the Core Exam and one category exam (*a topic related to their worksite*) to get their Commercial Applicator's License.
