



# Dairy Cattle Entry Requirements

**All Cattle Entering Arizona need:**

**Entry Permit Number**

Issued by calling **602-542-4293**  
 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Mon to Fri AZ Time  
 Valid for 30 days  
 No permit required if using an ECVI,  
 if using paper CVI Arizona will still  
 require a permit number to enter,  
 which will start with IP.

**Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)**

- Issued by an Accredited II Veterinarian
- Valid for 30 days
- Copies of CVI must have an original veterinarian signature
- All Official IDs must be listed on CVI or as an attachment

**Official Identification**

- **Dairy Steers:** Federal Ear Tag all ages
- **Cows/Heifers:** Orange Bangs Tag or Federal Ear Tag with Brucellosis Vaccination Tattoo
- **Bulls:** Federal Ear Tag if older than 18 months
- **Calves:** Federal Ear Tag all ages



**Specific Disease Testing Requirements**

**Tuberculosis:**

All Intact Dairy Cattle 4 months or older must be tested for Tuberculosis prior to entry into Arizona

- They must test negative within 60 days prior to entry into Arizona
- Tuberculosis Accredited Free herds are exempt from testing (Accredited number must be listed on CVI)

**Brucellosis**

- All Dairy Females 4 months of age or older MUST be official calfhood vaccinates for Brucellosis except:
  - Show cattle for exhibition, cattle consigned directly to slaughter, or cattle consigned for feeding purposes to a feedlot
- The Brucellosis Vaccination Tattoo must be listed on the CVI

**Trichomonas**

- All Dairy Bulls 12 months of age and older and NOT consigned to a Dairy must test negative for Trichomonas
- Sample to be collected by an Accredited Veterinarian and submitted at an approved lab: One negative P.C.R. test (or 3 negative cultures no less than 7 days apart) within **30** days prior to shipment
- The bulls must have no breeding activity from test date until arrival
